- From 2009 – 2016 he has coached the Canadian Women’s National team with appearances at the World Championships in Japan 2010 and 2014 in Italy, Pan Am Games in Mexico 2011 and Toronto in 2015, Grand Prix in 2014, 2015 and 2016.
- Coached Dresdner SC (Germany) women’s team from 2002 – 2009. Built up a team with a lot of young players and medaled the last 5 years in a row. 3rd, 3rd, 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the German Championship. Almost all of the players from Dresden were members of the German National Team. 6 players from Dresden won the silver medal with Team Germany at the European Championships in 2011.
- Played with the Dresdner SC in European Cup 2008 and won the Bronze Medal
- Assistant coach for Team Germany from 1999 – 2002. With the National Team he went to the 2000 Olympics in Sydney to the European Championships 2001 in Germany and to the World GrandPrix 2002
- Coached SSV Ulm (Germany) women’s team 1998 – 2002. Brought this team in his first year into the first league with a perfect season. Stayed with the team in the first league for three years.
- Started teaching this summer at Westwood Collegiate, where he coached the Junior Varsity girls.
